HOW TO ARRIVE TO EGER:

Place of competition – Ferenc Kemény Sport Hall, Str. Stadion 8, (Eger, Hungary

Airport: The closest airport is Budapest Ferihegy Airport, 130 km from Eger. Transport from Budapest airport to Eger (and return) can be arranged by the organizer.

Transport: Persons who need Transport must contact the organizer (Zoltan Tímár, Mobile: +36703829043)

Email: zoltim69@gmail.com informing him of the date, time, place and any relevant information such as flight number and airline. Airport: The closest airport is Budapest Ferihegy Airport, 130 km from Eger. Transport from Budapest airport to Eger (and return).

If you announce your arrival 15 march 2026. After this date, the cost can be more expensive.

Train: Should you travel on the train from Budapest, you can choose from 4 express trains and an InterCity train of Hungarian State Railways (InterCity requires seat reservation)

There are some other opportunities if you change train in Füzesabony.

Exchange rate guide: 1Euro = 390 HUF (this may change)

Car or bus: If you travel by car or bus from Budapest there are two highways: Highway 25 (Kerecsend-Ózd), and Highway 24 (Gyöngyös-Recsk-Eger).

From the M3 Motorway you will cross Füzesabony and Maklár, or on Highway 25 you will cross Kerecsend.

The event manager for accommodation, Mr. Zoltan Timar will organize transport from the **BUDAPEST AIRPORT** to **Budapest and back.**

You need to contact Mr. Zoltan Timar before 15th of March 2026 to book transportation and to find out information about the prices. After this date the prices will be 50% higher.

The price depends of the type of transport (Car / Auto: max 4 people, Minibus: 7-8 people, Bus: 17 people, Bus: 35 people, Bus: 49 people).

Budapest airport: car: 70 EUR /person (2 people/car), 50 EUR / person (4 people)

Mini autobus: 7- 8 people: 40 EUR / person, Autobus: 15-17 person: 35 EUR / person

Autobus: more than 20 people: 30 EUR / person

If the distance between the accommodation and the sport's hall requires daily transportation extra costs will apply.

ACCOMMODATION

If the accommodation is sold out, we will help you find it. If someone books through us and cancels, they will have to pay the accommodation fee.

All the participants: competitors, coaches, referees and officials have the chance to book various types of accommodation. The prices of the accommodation is very attractive and will be with half board (breakfast, and dinner). The price it is different according with the type of the room and number of the persons accommodated in a room.

Accommodation (different price one, two or more person/room)

Hotel Unicornis *** (80 persons) (60-70 Euro/ person/day, with breakfast, diner)

Hotel Minaret*** (80 persons) (60-70 Euro/ person/day, with breakfast, diner)

Hotel Korona*** (80 persons) (65 Euro/ person/day, with breakfast)

Hotel Eger **** (200 persons) (70-85 Euro/ person/day, with breakfast)

More Hotel in Eger ** or *** category (45-55 Euro/ person/day, with breakfast)

Students Campus lodging is available for 100 persons for €20 /day (4 persons/room, toilets and showers on the hall) not breakfast.

The prices on the hotel web pages are different from the above price because they are still the 2026 prices. The prices also differ between hotels. We calculated an average price so everyone has to pay the same. Some of the rooms will have extra beds. This was the only way we could negotiate the current price. Hotels are not far away from the Sport Hall. The longest route is max. 5 -15 minutes by foot.

OFFICIALS

Referees and Judges will need to register on Sportdata before 20st March 2026.

The chief referee will confirm registered referees and judges, SKDUN qualified referees and judges will have their previously issued ID and qualification badges, these will allow automatic entry as SKDUN officials to all areas of the venue as required. Please remember to bring your SKDUN official issued ID and ties, red for referees and blue for judges.

Non SKDUN qualified applicants will be selected and will have a badge issued as required by the competition chief referee designate, Damir Milosavljevic. Any enquiries or questions contact Damir Milosavljevic, Email: dmrmls@gmail.com ,

Referees and judges, please ensure you have registered on Sportdata and include the days you will be available. **IMPORTANT**, please let the chief referee, Damir Milosavljevic know in advance if you have registered but cannot attend due to illness, work etc. Those who are also competing (only allowed in Asai Ryu/Veteran categories, no other categories), please let him know in which categories you entered in order for him to accurately schedule and designate officials to the various tatami. It is your responsibility to bring your SKDUN ID badge and whistle.



EVENTS SCHEDULE

Thursday 16th April 2026

10:00 – 20:00: **REGISTRATION AND CHECKING WEIGHT FOR COMPETITORS** in Imre Hodos sport's hall. Without checking of weight, competitors will not be permitted to participate in kumite. Team managers can collect an envelope with the identity badges for their preregistered competitors, coaches and officials. Without their competition identity badges, they will not be allowed to enter the sports hall.

To avoid crowding in the Sport hall, delegations with many athletes (minimum 50 athletes) can weigh in at the hotel where they are staying. However, they must notify the hotel where they are staying at least 2 weeks in advance and establish with the organizer the time at which the athletes will checking of weight.

Anyone who has failed to register on Sportdata will not be given an official badge and will not be allowed access into the competition area! When you register on sportdata, all the participants (competitors, coaches, official) need to include one passport type photo.

Friday, April 17, 2026 (7 tatami)

8.30 – 19.00: 7 Tatami: SKDUN European Cup - Kohai: kata individual, kumite individual (all kumite categories specific to the European Cup), duo kata

Saturday, April 18, 2026 (7 tatami)

8.30 – 12.00: 2 or 3 Tatami: SKDUN European Cup: kata individual, kumite individual, duo kata

8.30 – 12.00: 4 or 5 Tatami: SKDUN European Championship: kata individual childrens, minicadets, cadets, seniors and kata team cadets and seniors

ENTRY FEES

Individual events - 40€ per person per event

Kata and Kumite Team events - 60€ per team per event

Duo Kata – 40 € per team

Registration fees for coaches – 30€ per coach

To protest - 50€ per protest (only one protest is allowed during one match if the protest is not correct)

There will be an ADDITIONAL LATE ENTRY ADMINISTRATION FEE for any accepted late registration after 15th October (+10€ for individual events and +25€ for team events).
